Felon Arrested During Traffic Stop for Possession of Narcotics and Firearm

In the early morning hours of September 11th, around 3:00 a.m., Shreveport Police Officers conducted a traffic stop at the intersection of Line Avenue and Monrovia Street. During the stop, officers contacted 24-year-old Dquayvius Jackson, who was driving the vehicle. Jackson was found to have a firearm and narcotics.

Further investigation revealed that Jackson is a convicted felon, making it illegal for him to possess a firearm. Jackson was promptly arrested and charged with possession of narcotics, illegal carrying of weapons, and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. This arrest marks Jackson's fifth firearm-related arrest since 2020.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to removing firearms from the hands of criminals and ensuring the safety of our community. This arrest is yet another example of the excellent work our officers perform daily as they confront and apprehend armed individuals.
