

Man Arrested in Shots Fired Incident

On August 21st, 2024, at approximately 2:00 AM, Shreveport Police Department (SPD) officers were dispatched to a shots-fired call at 126 East Olive Street. Upon arrival, officers spoke with the residents and discovered that their home had been shot at multiple times. Four individuals were inside the residence during the incident, but thankfully no one was injured.

SPD Violent Crimes Detectives conducted a thorough investigation, which led to an arrest warrant for 19-year-old Ty'Jaun Lafitte. Lafitte was charged with Illegal Use of Weapons or Dangerous Instrumentalities, Aggravated Criminal Damage to Property, and Possession of a Firearm or Carrying a Concealed Weapon by a Person Convicted of Certain Felonies.

On September 18th, 2024, with the assistance of Louisiana Probation and Parole Officers, Lafitte was apprehended and booked into the city jail. SPD will continue to relentlessly pursue those individuals who seek to cause violence in our community.
