**SHREVEPORT POLICE SOLVE ANOTHER SHOOTING INCIDENT**

On September 23, 2024, officers from the Shreveport Police Department responded to reports of shots fired in the 500 block of East 67th Street. According to initial reports, a male suspect, later identified as the ex-boyfriend of a woman living at the residence, drove by and fired multiple shots at the home before fleeing the scene.

At least one bullet struck the residence, where two females were inside. Fortunately, no one was injured during the incident.

A short time later, SPD patrol officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle fitting the suspect's description at the intersection of East 70th Street and Line Avenue. The driver, identified as 44-year-old Bryant Thomas, was taken into custody without incident. During the stop, it was determined that Thomas was driving while intoxicated.

Thomas was charged with the following offenses:

- Aggravated criminal property damage
- Assault by drive-by shooting
- Illegal use of a weapon
- Reckless operation of a vehicle
- Driving while intoxicated (DWI)

The Shreveport Police Department is grateful for the swift actions of the responding officers, which led to the quick resolution of this dangerous situation.
