Arrest Stems From Road Rage Complaint

On September 29, 2024, at approximately 1:00 PM, members of the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Abatement Team (VCAT) launched an investigation into a road rage incident. Following a thorough review of the case, VCAT members identified the suspect as 21-year-old Jaylon Blake (DOB 06/20/2003).

A search warrant was obtained for a residence located in the 400 block of Coventry Place. With assistance from the Shreveport City Marshal's Office and SPD's Warrant Unit, VCAT members executed the search warrant and successfully located Blake inside the residence. During the search, officers recovered narcotics and a firearm.

Jaylon Blake was arrested and charged with the following offenses:

- Possession of Schedule II controlled substance
- Possession of Schedule I controlled substance
- Aggravated Assault with a Firearm
