Armed Felon Arrested After Running Red Light

At approximately 11:18 PM on October 12, 2024, Shreveport Police Department officers observed a vehicle run a red light at the intersection of Murphy Street and Pete Harris Drive. Officers initiated a traffic stop, with the vehicle coming to a halt at Allen Avenue and Murphy Street.

The driver, identified as 48-year-old Zierich Snow (DOB: 9/28/76), was found to have active warrants for his arrest. During the course of the arrest, officers discovered that Snow was armed with a firearm. Further investigation revealed that he was prohibited from possessing a weapon due to a prior conviction for attempted second-degree murder.

Snow was taken into custody and charged with being a felon in possession of a firearm, multiple traffic violations, and the outstanding warrants.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to addressing the serious issue of gun possession by convicted felons and will continue to prioritize the safety of our community.
