Councilwoman Ursula Bowman to Support Bond Sales for Infrastructure and Public Safety Improvements

Shreveport, LA – Councilwoman Ursula Bowman has announced her support for the upcoming bond sales that will bolster Shreveport’s infrastructure and public safety improvements. After several discussions and careful planning, Bowman has decided to vote in favor of the \$88 million bond sale for essential street, water, and public facilities improvements, as well as an additional \$28.9 million in bonds dedicated to building a new, state-of-the-art police headquarters.

“For several meetings, I joined my colleagues in voting to postpone the \$88 million dollar bond sale until we had an actionable plan to move forward with a new, state-of-the-art police headquarters that is within our financial means,” said Councilwoman Bowman. “The Mayor listened to our concerns, and as a result, I will be voting to approve the sale of the \$88 million dollars of street, water, and public facilities bonds, as well as the \$28.9 million dollars of bonds for a new police headquarters at our next meeting on November 8th. Companies like Amazon and Curtis Jackson’s G-Unit believe in our city’s potential and have invested millions of dollars to grow our economy. Now is the time for us to invest in our city as well. The future of Shreveport is bright.”

The next vote on these bonds is scheduled for the City Council meeting on November 8, 2024.
