WOMAN WANTED FOR MURDER IN SHREVEPORT



Osamaria Madison

The Shreveport Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating Osamaria Madison, a 18-year-old black female, in connection with a murder that occurred on October 4, 2024.

At approximately 7:41 AM, officers from the Patrol Division responded to a shooting incident at 2600 Greenwood Road. Upon arrival, they discovered a black male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Tragically, the victim was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Violent Crime Investigators initiated an investigation and identified a possible crime scene. Preliminary investigations revealed that the victim was riding in a vehicle with another male when an unidentified vehicle pulled up and blocked their path. Two unknown black females exited the suspect vehicle and attempted to gain access to the victim's vehicle.

After successfully entering the vehicle, several shots were fired into it, striking the victim multiple times and resulting in fatal injuries.

Osamaria Madison has been identified as a suspect in this violent crime. She is also wanted in connection with an Attempted Murder and Home invasion in the 2023 incident that took place on Gavin Lane in west Shreveport.
