Shreveport Police Domestic Violence Detectives Seek Two Men Wanted in Separate Incidents

Shreveport Police Department's Domestic Violence Unit is actively searching for two men wanted in connection with separate incidents involving domestic abuse. Detectives are urging the public's assistance to locate these individuals and prevent further harm.

On September 29, a victim reported that her boyfriend, Kendrick Davenport, had inflicted serious bodily injury by using force and violence against her without her consent. Davenport also allegedly brandished a handgun, pointing it at both the victim and her juvenile son, while making threats to harm them. The victim sustained a fractured nose and facial contusions as a result of the assault.

Davenport has a criminal history that includes a previous guilty plea for Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment on August 21, 2020, involving a different victim. After reviewing all evidence in this latest case, detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Kendrick Davenport on charges of Domestic Abuse Battery with Serious Bodily Injury, Domestic Abuse Battery 2nd Offense, and two counts of Domestic Abuse Aggravated Assault.

In a separate incident reported on September 24, another victim reported that her boyfriend, Maurice Spearman, used force and violence against her without her consent, this time using a dangerous weapon and causing visible injuries. Spearman also has a history of domestic battery offenses. Detectives obtained a warrant for Maurice Spearman for Domestic Abuse Battery with a Dangerous Weapon.

The Shreveport Police Department reminds the public that love should never hurt and urges anyone with information on the whereabouts of Kendrick Davenport or Maurice Spearman to come forward. Help us prevent these individuals from causing further harm.
