**Arrest of Felon with Firearm**



**Corey Williams**

Shreveport Police have arrested 21-year-old Corey Williams following an investigation into a domestic violence incident that began on November 5, 2024.

Officers responded to a domestic violence call in the 1900 block of Doris Street, where they determined that Williams had been involved in the incident and was in possession of firearms. Upon further investigation, police learned that Williams was a convicted felon due to a 2022 conviction for the illegal use of a weapon from a motor vehicle.

On November 22, 2024, members of the Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Abatement Team apprehended Williams. He has been charged with multiple offenses, including:

- Felon in possession of a firearm
- Criminal property damage
- Domestic abuse battery
- Theft of a motor vehicle

The Shreveport Police Department emphasizes that any violations of firearm possession laws by prohibited persons will be treated with the utmost seriousness. All recovered firearms involved in such cases will be removed from circulation and destroyed to enhance community safety.
