**17-Year-Old Arrested for Attempted Murder**

On November 25, 2024, Shreveport Police Department patrol officers responded to a shooting in the 3100 block of Ashton Street. Upon arrival, officers found a victim near the roadway suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to Ochsner LSU Health Shreveport with life-threatening injuries.

SPD Homicide Detectives immediately launched an investigation, working tirelessly day and night to identify the shooter. Their efforts led to the identification of 17-year-old Kyland Morris (DOB: 09/05/2007) as the suspect. Detectives developed probable cause, and an arrest warrant for Attempted Second-Degree Murder was issued.

On December 3, 2024, SPD Homicide Detectives located and arrested Morris. The victim in this case remains alive, and their condition continues to be monitored.

This case highlights the dedication and exceptional investigative work of the Shreveport Police Department's Homicide Team. Their commitment to justice ensures that violent offenders are held accountable for their actions.
