Arrest Made in Early 2024 Domestic Violence Case

On February 5, 2024, at approximately 1:00 AM, Shreveport Police officers responded to a local hospital where a female victim was being treated for injuries allegedly caused by Steve Harrison Jr. During the investigation, it was determined that Harrison had intentionally used force and violence against the victim, causing serious bodily harm and engaging in harassing behavior.

Detectives with the Domestic Violence Unit learned that the victim, Ms. Wright, sustained significant injuries, including a fractured nose. After a thorough review of evidence, detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Harrison on October 1, 2024, for the following charges:

- Battery of a Dating Partner with Serious Bodily Injury
- Battery of a Dating Partner with Strangulation
- Improper Telephone Communications

On December 3, 2024, at approximately 9:50 PM, Harrison was located and arrested by the SPD Warrants Unit.

Domestic violence is a serious issue, and the Shreveport Police Department remains committed to protecting victims and bringing offenders to justice. We encourage anyone experiencing domestic violence to seek help and utilize available resources.
