Shreveport Police Investigating Fatal Shooting at Vacant Residence

On Saturday, December 14, 2024, at approximately 10:55 p.m., Shreveport Police Department patrol officers responded to reports of a shooting in the 100 block of Pierremont Road. Upon arrival, officers learned that a large party was taking place at a vacant residence when an unidentified vehicle drove past and fired multiple shots toward the house and crowd.

All victims were transported to Ochsner LSU Health Shreveport. Tragically, an 18-year-old male victim was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival. The three other victims are reported to be in stable condition and are expected to make full recoveries.

Multiple witnesses were transported to the SPD Violent Crimes Office for interviews. The investigation is ongoing, and Shreveport Police are urging anyone with information about this incident to come forward.
