## Shreveport City Council Public Safety Committee Expresses Concern Over Recent Tragic Shooting, Pledges Support to Law Enforcement and Sympathy to Victims

*Shreveport, LA* — The Shreveport City Council Public Safety Committee is deeply concerned by the tragic drive-by shooting that took place Saturday night in the 100 block of Pierremont Road, leaving one young person dead and three others injured.

Chairman of the Public Safety Committee, Councilman Gary Brooks, expressed his sorrow and resolve: “This loss is devastating, not only to the family but to our entire community. Violence like this cannot and will not be tolerated. As leaders, we are committed to ensuring our law enforcement has the resources they need to bring those responsible to justice and to prevent future tragedies like this.”

Councilwoman Tabatha Taylor added: “Our hearts go out to the family and friends mourning this tragic loss. This incident is a stark reminder of the importance of collaboration between the community, law enforcement, and local leadership. We must focus on community engagement, accountability, and resources to address the deeper issues contributing to this violence.”

The Committee, along with other council members, strongly condemns this senseless act of violence and reaffirms its commitment to public safety. The Shreveport City Council Public Safety Committee will continue to work with the Shreveport Police Department, community leaders, and residents to develop solutions to address crime and promote safer neighborhoods.

Councilwoman Ursula Bowman, stated: “Incidents like this are heartbreaking, but they also strengthen our resolve to make Shreveport a safer place. We stand with our law enforcement officers as they work to investigate and hold those responsible accountable. We encourage anyone with information to come forward—helping bring justice is a shared responsibility.”
