Arrest Made in 2024 Shooting Incident

The Shreveport Police Department has made an arrest in connection to a shooting incident that occurred in June 2024. On January 5, 2025, just after 5:00 PM, Obryan Taylor was taken into custody on an outstanding warrant related to the case.

The incident occurred on June 25, 2024, at approximately 11:20 PM, when patrol officers were dispatched to 6242 Southcrest Drive in response to a disorderly person and vandalism call. Upon arrival, officers learned that a disagreement between Taylor and the victim had escalated, resulting in Taylor pulling out a handgun and firing multiple shots at the victim.

The victim sought cover behind a vehicle, which was struck three times by gunfire. Fortunately, the victim was not injured. Taylor fled the scene on foot before officers arrived.

After interviewing witnesses and gathering evidence, detectives obtained an arrest warrant for Taylor on one count of Aggravated Criminal Damage to Property.

Taylor's arrest underscores the commitment of the Shreveport Police Department to holding offenders accountable and ensuring the safety of the community.
