**Three Wanted in Separate Domestic Violence Incidents**



The Shreveport Police Department is seeking the public's help in locating three individuals wanted in connection with separate domestic violence incidents.

- **Jaiquane Niamathalli (B/M):** On November 17, 2024, at approximately 11:30 AM, the victim reported that her boyfriend, Jaiquane Niamathalli, used intentional force or violence against her without her consent. The incident occurred in the presence of his juvenile sister, who is under 13 years old. A relative witnessed the assault, and the victim was transported to LSU Hospital for treatment of her injuries. After reviewing all evidence, an arrest warrant was obtained for Niamathalli for Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment.
- **Shadiamond Beverly (B/F):** On November 6, 2024, at approximately 6:50 AM, the victim reported that his girlfriend, Shadiamond Beverly, assaulted him using a dangerous weapon. Detectives discovered the victim had sustained a stab wound and was transported to LSU Hospital, where he is expected to recover. Following an investigation, an arrest warrant was issued for Beverly for Battery of a Dating Partner with Serious Bodily Injury.

- **Nickolas Green (W/M):** On November 29, 2024, around 8:00 AM, the victim reported that her ex-boyfriend, Nickolas Green, violated a protective order issued on September 13, 2023, by stalking and harassing her. The victim provided photographic and video evidence of Green following her, arriving at her residence without consent, and contacting her repeatedly via phone. Records revealed that Green contacted the victim approximately 46 times while the protective order was active and 162 times on October 31, 2024, alone. Based on this evidence, an arrest warrant was obtained for Green for Stalking, Improper Telephone Communications, and Violation of Protective Order.

The Shreveport Police Department urges anyone with information on the whereabouts of these individuals to come forward.
