Man Arrested for Threatening Family with Firearm

On January 7, 2025, at approximately 10:13 AM, Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to a residence at 6110 Fairfield Avenue regarding an armed person.

According to information provided by the dispatcher, a caller reported that her 23-year-old son had been arguing with family members inside the home. The suspect then discharged a firearm into the ground, escalating the situation.

When officers arrived, witnesses directed them to the rear (west side) of the residence, where the suspect, identified as Ellis Moran (DOB 06/13/2001), was located with a black handgun. Officers acted swiftly to take Moran into custody without further incident.

Moran was charged with aggravated assault with a firearm and illegal use of a weapon. This incident highlights the exceptional work of SPD patrol officers in ensuring public safety. The Shreveport Police Department reminds everyone that firearms should never be used to settle disputes, as doing so endangers lives and can lead to severe legal consequences.
