

Three Arrested in Connection with Southern Cycle Shop Burglary

Shreveport Police Department (SPD) property crimes detectives, along with SPD SWAT team members, executed a search warrant on January 8, 2025, at a residence located at 4014 Crosby Street. This search was conducted as part of an ongoing investigation into a burglary at the Southern Cycle Shop, located at 7702 Jewella Avenue.

Upon executing the warrant, SPD detectives and agents made contact with three individuals inside the residence. A subsequent search of the property led to the seizure of several items, including a stolen Glock 23 handgun, Schedule II narcotics, and drug paraphernalia.

Further investigation revealed that suspects Lenice Bolton and Stantavious Underwood, both convicted felons, were prohibited from possessing firearms due to prior felony convictions. Both individuals were found to have possession of the stolen Glock and the narcotics found during the search. Bolton was also found to have a fugitive warrant and a local warrant for unrelated charges.

Anthony Brown was found to be in connection with the investigation and involvement in the burglary at the Southern Cycle Shop.

As a result of the investigation and arrests, the following individuals were booked into the Shreveport City Jail on their respective charges:

 - Illegal Possession of Stolen Firearm (14:69.1)
