Man Arrested in Connection to 2024 Home Invasion

Shreveport Police have arrested a suspect in connection with a violent home invasion that occurred on November 24, 2024, in the 2800 block of Gloria Drive.

On the day of the incident, officers responded to a report of an armed person and discovered a female victim bleeding from the mouth and a residence with significant damage. An investigation revealed that Jacoby Kinsey had forced his way into the home by physically pushing down the complainant. During the attack, Kinsey also threw a child's toy through the front window, further damaging the property.

Kinsey reportedly threatened multiple individuals at the residence with a firearm before fleeing the scene. Despite extensive efforts, officers were unable to locate him immediately after the incident.

A warrant was subsequently issued for Kinsey's arrest, charging him with:

- One count of Home Invasion
- Multiple counts of Child Endangerment
- Property Damage

On January 13, 2025, Kinsey was taken into custody by the Shreveport Police Department's Warrants Unit, with assistance from the Shreveport City Marshal's Office.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to thoroughly investigating and addressing offenses that threaten the safety and well-being of our community.
