Armed Man Arrested Following Disturbance

On January 18, 2025, Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to a residence at 2320 Highland Avenue in reference to a disorderly person. The complainant reported that a relative, who was not supposed to be at the residence, was causing a disturbance by beating on the front door and damaging the security camera.

Upon arrival, officers spoke with the homeowner, who stated the subject had left on foot heading north on Highland Avenue. Officers proceeded to the area and observed a heavy-set male wearing a large beige/brown jacket and black sweatpants walking eastbound in the roadway near the 400 block of College Street, just before Gilbert Drive, despite a sidewalk being available.

Officers made contact with the individual, who initially identified himself falsely. The subject was later correctly identified as Jahron Robertson (DOB: 12/5/2000).

During a pat-down search, officers discovered that Robertson had an outstanding warrant through the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office for Domestic Abuse charges. Further investigation revealed that Robertson was a convicted felon, stemming from a 2023 conviction for Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment on April 11, 2023.

Robertson was taken into custody, and during a search incident to arrest, officers found a black handgun concealed in one of the inside pockets of his jacket, along with narcotics.

Robertson was arrested for the following offenses:

- Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon
- Possession of Narcotics
- Outstanding Warrant for Domestic Abuse Charges
- Providing False Information to Law Enforcement

Robertson was transported to the Shreveport City Jail, where he was booked on these charges. The Shreveport Police Department is committed to ensuring the safety of its residents and addressing criminal behavior swiftly and effectively.
