Violent Felon Cartilieus Claville Apprehended After Multi-Agency Effort

On Wednesday, January 22, 2025, members of the Shreveport Police Department's Office of Special Investigations, in partnership with the U.S. Marshals Violent Offender Taskforce, apprehended Cartilieus Claville, a violent felon wanted for multiple crimes.

Investigators received information regarding Claville's whereabouts through community tips and Crime Stoppers leads. Officers tracked him throughout the day to a location in north Shreveport.

When Claville became a passenger in a vehicle, officers conducted a felony traffic stop. Both the driver and another passenger exited the vehicle, but Claville moved into the driver's seat and fled the scene in the vehicle without the owner's consent.

A brief vehicle pursuit ensued, during which Claville wrecked the vehicle he was driving. He was taken into custody shortly thereafter without further incident.

Claville was booked into the Shreveport City Jail on multiple active warrants, including:

- Attempted Second-Degree Murder (x2)
- Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon
- Illegal Possession of Stolen Things
- Aggravated Flight from an Officer
- Resisting Arrest

This arrest was made possible thanks to the collaborative efforts of law enforcement and the invaluable assistance of the community through Crime Stoppers tips.
