Detectives Seek Assistance in Locating Felony Suspect

On January 21, 2025, Shreveport Police Department detectives were contacted by an active patrol officer regarding a stolen vehicle investigation involving a known suspect who had previously evaded officers.

The investigation began on January 20, 2025, at approximately 11:50 p.m., when a stolen vehicle report was dispatched to the 4910 block of W Monkhouse Drive. While canvassing the area, officers spotted the vehicle traveling along Hollywood Avenue. A traffic stop was initiated, and the vehicle briefly came to a stop. However, the driver was uncooperative, refused to exit the vehicle, and fled the scene.

A short pursuit led officers to the rear of the Super 8 Motel at 4910 W Monkhouse Drive. The suspect abandoned the vehicle, jumped a fence, and fled into the Westwood Park neighborhood on foot. Upon inspecting the vehicle, officers discovered a loaded firearm in the driver's seat.

Further investigation led officers to identify the suspect as Damien Clark (Black male, 12/4/1994). A comparison of body camera footage and known photographs confirmed Clark as the individual involved in the incident.

Clark, a convicted felon prohibited from possessing firearms due to a prior conviction for Simple Burglary, is now wanted on the following charges:

- Felon in Possession of a Firearm
- Aggravated Flight from an Officer
- Theft of a Motor Vehicle
- Resisting an Officer (LA R.S. 14:108)
