





Man Arrested After High-Speed Chase Ends in Crash

Shreveport Police have arrested Scott Crawford following a high-speed chase that ended in a collision on January 23, 2025.

On Thursday, just after 5:00 PM, officers attempted to stop a Ford Fusion near Fairfield Avenue and Pierremont Road. The driver, later identified as Crawford, refused to pull over, leading officers on a chase through the city. The pursuit ended near Ontario and Thornhill Streets when Crawford's vehicle collided with a red Camaro.

Crawford attempted to flee on foot after the crash but was quickly apprehended by Shreveport Police officers. During the arrest, officers discovered that the passenger in the vehicle, Angel Owens, was wanted on outstanding narcotics warrants.

Fortunately, no one sustained serious injuries as a result of the crash. Crawford now faces multiple charges, including aggravated flight from an officer, several counts of narcotics possession, and multiple traffic offenses.

Aggravated flight from an officer is a serious crime punishable by up to 10 years in prison. This incident highlights the outstanding efforts of Shreveport Police officers, who remain dedicated to removing criminals from our streets and keeping the community safe.
