**Shreveport Police Make Significant Progress in Walgreens Homicide
Investigation**

Homicide detectives with the Shreveport Police Department have made significant progress in the investigation of the recent homicide at Walgreens. Over the past 72 hours, investigators with the Violent Crimes Unit have worked tirelessly to identify those responsible for this tragic crime.

A warrant has been issued for Kelvin Lewis (07/25/86), charging him with one count of Second-Degree Murder. Kelvin Lewis was arrested in Arlington, Texas yesterday on unrelated violent offense charges. Detectives are still actively seeking Larry Lewis for his involvement in this heinous act.

Shreveport Police Chief Wayne Smith expressed his gratitude to the community for their overwhelming support and the valuable information provided during this investigation. “This calculated and heinous crime shook our community to its core. Thanks to the relentless work of our Violent Crimes Unit and the cooperation of the public, we have made critical progress toward bringing justice to the victim and their family,” said Chief Smith.

Detectives continue to piece together information and remain committed to holding all responsible parties accountable. Additional arrests may be forthcoming as the investigation remains ongoing.
