**MAYOR ARCENEUX'S OFFICE COMMENDS SHREVEPORT POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR
SWIFT ACTION IN RECENT HOMICIDE CASES**

The City of Shreveport has seen three tragic homicides in 2025, two of which have already been closed with arrests, thanks to the swift and decisive actions of the Shreveport Police Department. Mayor Tom Arceneaux extends his heartfelt condolences to the families and loved ones of the victims whose lives were senselessly taken.

"Our hearts go out to the families and friends who are mourning these tragic losses," said Mayor Arceneaux. "We stand with you in this difficult time and remain committed to doing everything possible to bring justice and accountability."

In one recent case, Shreveport Police responded to a homicide at a local Popeyes, and within hours of the incident, officers arrested a suspect, closing the case with remarkable speed. In another incident, detectives worked tirelessly following a fatal shooting at a Walgreens, arresting Calvin Lewis within a week of the crime.

Mayor Arceneaux commended the police department for their dedication and professionalism in these cases. "The Shreveport Police Department has shown exemplary resolve and commitment to protecting our community. Their ability to close these cases so quickly demonstrates the level of skill and determination they bring to their work every day."

Investigators continue to work diligently to locate Kelvin Lewis's brother, who remains at large in connection with the Walgreens shooting. The Mayor's Office urges anyone with information about this case to come forward by contacting Crime Stoppers at (318) 673-7373. Tips can remain anonymous.

As Shreveport grieves the loss of these lives, the city remains steadfast in its commitment to creating a safer community for all residents. Together, we can honor the memories of those lost by working together to ensure a safer and more secure future for Shreveport.
