Another Felon Arrested With A Firearm



On February 3, 2024, Shreveport Police were investigating a suspicious person when they arrested a man later identified as Brandon Harris. Initially, Harris provided a false name, which was discovered upon his arrival at Shreveport City Jail. Further investigation revealed that Harris had outstanding warrants from the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office and was a convicted felon. Harris was also found to be in possession of a stolen firearm, making it an additional offense.

With the assistance of the Violent Crimes Abatement Team, Harris was arrested and charged with:

- Felon in Possession of a Firearm
- Possession of a Stolen Firearm
- Misrepresentation During Booking
- Additional charges pending further investigation

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to removing illegal firearms from the hands of criminals and ensuring the safety of the community. The SPD will continue its efforts to reduce gun violence through proactive enforcement and community partnerships.
