Shreveport Police Arrest TONIQUE SELLERS for Multiple Charges

Shreveport Police have arrested Tonique Sellers on multiple charges following an incident on February 4, 2025.

At approximately 11:30 AM, members of the Shreveport Police Violent Crimes Abatement Team were conducting an operation in the 2900 block of Peach Street when they encountered a suspicious individual. The individual immediately fled on foot but was apprehended shortly thereafter. Sellers was found to be in possession of a firearm.

Upon further investigation, it was revealed that Tonique Sellers is a convicted felon and prohibited from possessing a firearm. Sellers was arrested for negligent carrying of a firearm and has a criminal history involving multiple firearms-related offenses. Sellers was previously found guilty of illegal possession of a firearm with a controlled dangerous substance in 2023.

The Shreveport Police Department remains focused on ensuring the safety of our community by continuing to track down and apprehend individuals prohibited from possessing firearms.
