Shreveport Police Seek Wanted Woman for Bank Fraud



Tashiuntay Miles

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department's White Collar Crimes Unit have obtained an arrest warrant for 33-year-old Tashiuntay Miles in connection with a bank fraud case involving more than \$60,000.

The investigation began on January 8, 2025, after SPD received a report from Legacy National Bank regarding a fraudulent transaction. Detectives determined that on August 29, 2024, Miles deposited a check in the amount of \$61,611.31 at a Carter Federal Credit Union ATM. On September 6, 2024, she entered the Carter Federal Credit Union Bert Kouns branch and withdrew \$60,000 through cashier's checks.

The check was originally made payable to Mayekawa U.S.A. and drawn on a Legacy National Bank account under the name of George Foods, LLC. It was later returned as fraudulent, and investigators determined that Miles was not authorized to negotiate the check. Further examination revealed the check was manufactured, containing Miles' personal address and signature.

Detectives obtained video surveillance footage confirming Miles' identity, which was cross-referenced with her photo ID retrieved from the Louisiana Fusion Center.

On February 5, 2025, an arrest warrant was issued for Tashiuntay Miles on one count of Bank Fraud (LA R.S. 14:71.1).
