Voluntary Boil Advisory Issued for University Park

The City of Shreveport's Department of Water & Sewerage has issued a voluntary boil advisory for residents in the University Park area due to emergency repair work today. The impacted locations include:

- 2500-2600 Block of Kemp Lane
- 1300 Block of Audrey Lane
- 2600-2700 Blocks of Circle Drive

Water service was temporarily disrupted, now residents in these areas are advised to boil water before consumption, including drinking, cooking, or brushing teeth, as a precautionary measure. Water should be brought to a full rolling boil for at least one minute and allowed to cool before use.

The Louisiana Department of Health will lift the advisory once laboratory testing confirms the water is safe for consumption. Residents will be notified when the advisory is rescinded.
