Shreveport City Council Issues Statement on the Tragic Homicide of Christian Gant

Shreveport, LA – Councilman Jim Taliaferro (District C) and Councilman Grayson Boucher (District D) extend their deepest condolences to the family and loved ones of Christian Gant, who was tragically shot and killed while making a food delivery in the community.

The loss of Christian Gant is a heartbreaking reminder of the violence that continues to impact Shreveport. No one should have their life cut short in such a senseless act. His family, friends, and all who knew him are in our thoughts during this difficult time.

The Shreveport Police Department is actively investigating this incident, pursuing multiple leads, and gathering critical evidence to ensure that those responsible are brought to justice. Continued cooperation from the public is essential, and anyone with information is urged to come forward.

The safety and security of all residents remain a top priority. City leadership, law enforcement, and community partners will continue working together to address crime and create a safer environment for everyone.
