Homicide Investigation Following Assault on Commerce Street

On January 26, 2025, at approximately 5:38 a.m., Shreveport Police Department (SPD) patrol officers and Shreveport Fire Department (SFD) medics responded to an assault and battery call at 400 Commerce Street. Upon arrival, officers discovered an unconscious white male victim suffering from severe facial and head injuries. Witnesses reported that a Black male suspect struck the victim in the face, rendering him unconscious. The victim fell backward, striking his head on the sidewalk, while the suspect fled the scene.

SFD medics determined the victim had sustained life-threatening injuries and transported him to Ochsner LSU Health Shreveport for emergency medical treatment. The on-call investigator was notified and immediately responded to the hospital to check on the victim's condition.

During the investigation, hospital staff informed authorities that a witness had come forward, identifying the suspect as Trevor Moses (04/07/1999). Additionally, SPD patrol officers, along with the Real-Time Crime Center (RTCC), reviewed surveillance footage corroborating the witness account. As a result, Moses was arrested and charged with Second Degree Battery on February 6, 2025.

On February 15, 2025, at approximately 12:15 a.m., Shreveport Police received notification that the victim had succumbed to his injuries, elevating the case to a homicide investigation. Preliminary findings indicate that the victim and Moses had just left the Sand Bar in the 400 block of Spring Street when an altercation ensued. The conflict continued onto the 400 block of Commerce Street, where the fatal assault occurred.

The Shreveport Police Department is working closely with the Caddo Parish District Attorney's Office to determine if additional charges, including upgraded homicide charges, will be pursued against Moses. This investigation remains active, and updates will be provided as more information becomes available.
