Arrest Made in Armed Robbery at Dollar General

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department have arrested a suspect in connection with an armed robbery that occurred at a local Dollar General.

On February 25, 2025, at approximately 8:00 PM, officers responded to reports of an armed robbery at Dollar General, located at 8150 Line Avenue. Upon arrival, detectives interviewed the victim and learned that a suspect entered the store armed with what appeared to be a sawed-off shotgun and demanded money. The suspect fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of cash in an unknown direction.

Through the course of the investigation, detectives identified the suspect as possibly being a former employee of the store, Marquita Marshall. Surveillance footage was reviewed, and investigators noted similarities between the suspect's height, walk, and other characteristics matching Marshall.

On March 3, 2025, detectives obtained a search warrant for Marshall's residence. The following day, March 4, 2025, members of the Violent Crimes and Property Crimes Units executed the warrant at a residence in the 600 block of Rainbow Drive. Marshall was located at the residence and taken into custody without incident.

During the search, detectives recovered items of evidentiary value related to the robbery. As a result, Marquita Marshall was arrested and charged with First-Degree Robbery.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to holding offenders accountable and ensuring the safety of our community. If convicted, Marshall could serve up to 40 years in prison.
