Shreveport Police Investigate Shooting on Braebrook Drive

On March 9, 2025, at approximately 12:32 a.m., Shreveport Police officers responded to a shooting in the 400 block of Braebrook. Upon arrival, officers located 18-year-old Jayden Hill, a Black male, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the lower extremities. Hill was transported to LSU Health Shreveport with what were initially believed to be life-threatening injuries.

Detectives later interviewed Hill at the hospital, where he stated that he had arrived at the location with an individual identified as Monroe and an unknown Black male. Hill claimed he exited the vehicle to get closer to the residence for WiFi access. During this time, a physical altercation ensued between Hill and another male. The fight escalated when the second male produced a firearm, leading to a struggle over the weapon.

Once separated, Hill retrieved his own firearm and fired multiple rounds in the direction of the other individual. After all parties fled the scene, Hill disposed of his firearm in a nearby trash can.

Through further investigation, detectives determined that Hill had gone to the location to purchase narcotics. Based on the evidence, Hill was arrested and charged with Illegal Use of Weapons and Obstruction of Justice.
