Shots Fired Incident Quickly Resolved by SPD Officers and Detectives

On March 25, 2025, at approximately 10:27 a.m., Shreveport Police Department patrol officers responded to a shots fired call near Linwood Avenue and Hollywood Avenue. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the victim, who advised that after exiting the liquor store located at 1959 Hollywood Avenue, he was approached by a suspect. The suspect armed himself with an assault rifle, pointed it at the victim, and fired as the victim attempted to leave the scene in his vehicle.

Believing the suspect had fled into a nearby residence, patrol officers secured the home at 1918 Hollywood Avenue. A search warrant was obtained, but no one was located inside the residence.

A short time later, the suspect was located, detained, and transported to the Shreveport Police Department's Detective's Office for questioning. Following interviews, Rodney Calhoun was charged with the following offenses:

- LA R.S. 14:37.4 — Aggravated Assault with a Firearm
- LA R.S. 14:94 — Illegal Use of a Firearm
