Shreveport Woman Arrested for Domestic Violence and Home Invasion

On March 28, 2025, just after 7:00 p.m., officers with the Shreveport Police Department responded to a domestic violence call in the 2800 block of Milan Street. Upon arrival, officers learned that a male victim had been stabbed by his ex-girlfriend during an altercation.

Investigators determined that the suspect, identified as Latonya Kennon, had reportedly forced her way into her ex-boyfriend's residence and attacked him, stabbing him with a screwdriver. Officers observed that the victim had sustained a stab wound to the upper right side of his back. He was transported to a local hospital for medical treatment.

A domestic violence detective was notified and responded to the scene. Following an investigation, officers located Kennon on March 31 and took her into custody. She has been charged with one count of home invasion and one count of domestic abuse battery with a dangerous weapon.

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to addressing domestic violence and ensuring the safety of our community. Anyone experiencing domestic violence is encouraged to seek help by calling local authorities or support services.
