## RETAIL THEFT OPERATION RESULTS



On March 26th and 27th, Shreveport Police Department Property Crimes Detectives teamed up with several regional Loss Prevention Supervisors to combat Organized Retail Theft at multiple locations within the City of Shreveport. The operation, named "March 2025 Blitz," was the first of several scheduled for this year.

The operation resulted in multiple arrests, detailed as follows:

### March 26, 2025

#### Lowe's

- One (1) arrest – Kevin Joseph Johnson (B/M, DOB 9/7/1966)
- Charges:
  - Habitual Theft (Felony)
  - Probation & Parole Violation Warrant (Felony)
  - Resisting an Officer
  - Possession of Drug Paraphernalia
  - Misdemeanor Theft Warrant (CMO)
- Johnson attempted to conceal and steal merchandise, including a two-pack of two-way radios valued at \$80. Upon detention, he provided a false identity and was found in possession of a glass smoking pipe. He had a prior felony warrant for probation violation and multiple previous theft convictions.

#### Target

- Two (2) arrests – Shaerial Anderson (B/F, DOB 2/13/2008) and Ray'shonda Anderson (B/F, DOB 3/25/2003)
- Charges:
  - Shaerial Anderson: Felony Theft
  - Ray'shonda Anderson: Misdemeanor Theft
- The two suspects concealed children's clothing in a baby stroller. The total value of stolen merchandise was \$570.23. Prior thefts linked to Shaerial Anderson amounted to \$717.32, making the aggregate total \$1,288.05, classifying her charge as felony theft.

## Bath & Body Works

- Three (3) arrests – Frances Martin (B/F, DOB 9/11/1987), Treniesha Thomas (B/F, DOB 1/6/1982), and Chadwick Woulard (B/M, DOB 9/4/1987)
- Charges:
  - Frances Martin: Habitual Theft (Felony) – Seven prior convictions, Felony Theft Warrant (Caddo)
  - Treniesha
  - Thomas: Misdemeanor Theft
  - Chadwick Woulard: Misdemeanor Theft
- The suspects stole various candles and products valued at \$901.59. Martin, with seven prior theft convictions, also had an active felony theft warrant through Caddo District Court.

## TJ Maxx

- One (1) arrest – Michael Griffin (B/M, DOB 1/13/1961)
- Charges:
  - Habitual Theft (Felony) – 19 prior convictions
- Griffin concealed undergarments in a duffel bag and bypassed all points of sale. Due to 19 prior convictions, he was charged with habitual felony theft.

## March 27, 2025

### TJ Maxx

- One (1) arrest – Anthony McCray (B/M, DOB 05/22/1981)
- Charges:
  - Habitual Theft (Felony) – Seven prior convictions
  - Felony Theft Warrant (Caddo)
- McCray concealed four sets of earbuds, each valued at \$39.99, and exited the store. Due to seven prior theft convictions and an outstanding felony theft warrant, he was charged accordingly.

## Conclusion

The "March 2025 Blitz" operation successfully identified and apprehended multiple repeat offenders engaged in retail theft. The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to combating organized retail crime and ensuring the safety and security of businesses in our community. Additional operations are scheduled throughout the year to deter and prosecute theft-related offenses.
