Suspicious Person Call Leads to Arrest of Armed Felon

On April 6, 2025, just after 2:00 p.m., Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of North Market Street in response to a report of a suspicious person at a local CVS Pharmacy.

According to dispatch information, an employee at the store reported that a Black male wearing dark clothing and carrying a backpack entered the store, pulled out a weapon, and appeared to be wearing a black ski mask over his face as he entered the bathroom. The suspect exited the bathroom and sat in a chair across from the pharmacy counter.

Upon arrival, officers located a man matching the description. He was observed wearing a black face covering around his neck. Officers swiftly took him into custody. The suspect initially denied being in possession of a firearm, but a search revealed a gun concealed in the left pocket of his jacket. Further investigation revealed that the firearm had been reported stolen.

The suspect, identified as Carldeudre Morgan, was found to be a convicted felon stemming from a previous second-degree murder charge that was later amended to aggravated battery, as well as an armed robbery conviction. As a convicted felon, Morgan is prohibited by law from possessing a firearm.

Morgan was arrested and booked on multiple charges, including:

- Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
- Possession of a stolen firearm
- Resisting an officer

The Shreveport Police Department commends the CVS employee for remaining calm and alert, and thanks the officers who responded quickly to prevent a potentially dangerous situation.
