Sexual Battery Suspect Taken Into Custody

On April 6, 2025, just after 3:00 p.m., Shreveport Police officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Topeka Street in reference to a reported sexual assault.

Upon arrival, officers made contact with the female victim who advised that the incident occurred during the early morning hours of April 4, around 2:00 a.m. She stated that she and a male known to her, identified as Christopher Lyons, were watching a movie when she fell asleep. The victim reported that she later woke up to find Lyons' arm around her and felt as though she had been sexually violated.

During the investigation, the victim was able to provide evidence from social media where Lyons appeared to admit to inappropriately touching her.

On April 8, 2025, officers located and took Lyons into custody without incident. He was subsequently charged with sexual battery.

Under Louisiana law, sexual battery is defined as the intentional touching of the anus or genitals of a victim without their consent. If convicted, Lyons could face up to 10 years in prison.
