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Voluntary Boil Advisory Issued Following Water Main Repair Work

The City of Shreveport's Department of Water & Sewerage has issued a **voluntary boil advisory** for portions of the city due to water main repair work affecting the area.

The impacted locations include:

- 1000 block of West Bert Kouns Industrial Loop
- 9400 & 9300 blocks of Blom Boulevard
- 9200 block of Hillside Avenue
- 1000 block of Ridgewood
- 1000 block of Belhaven
- 9400 & 9300 blocks of Baird Road
- 2100 block of Francais
- 2100 block of Waymon Drive
- 2100 block of Urban Dale
- 2100 block of Cynthia Lane

Out of an abundance of precaution, the Department of Water & Sewerage is issuing a **VOLUNTARY BOIL ADVISORY**, effective once water service is restored, and continuing until further notice.

This advisory will remain in effect until water samples are collected, analyzed, and confirmed to be free of coliform bacteria. Once satisfactory results are obtained, and with the approval of the Louisiana Department of Health, the Department of Water & Sewerage will rescind the advisory and notify residents that the water is safe for use.
