Repeat Offender Arrested in Lowe's Theft Case – Detectives Seeking Additional Victims

Shreveport Police detectives have arrested Tamira Caldwell (DOB: 8/6/1976) in connection with multiple thefts from a local Lowe's store. Caldwell, who was taken into custody on April 21, 2025, is a habitual retail theft offender with a lengthy criminal history.

The investigation revealed that on January 13, 2025, Caldwell and two accomplices stole approximately \$770 worth of merchandise from Lowe's. Surveillance footage confirmed Caldwell's involvement, and detectives later uncovered her extensive history of theft-related crimes.

Caldwell's Criminal Background Includes:

- 20 prior theft-related arrests, 15 convictions across three jurisdictions & Multiple arrests for issuing worthless checks

The two accomplices in the case, Jacolby Foster (B/M, DOB: 4/29/2000) and Vikeshia Murray (B/F, DOB: 8/16/2002), were also identified and are currently incarcerated at Caddo Correctional Center on unrelated charges.

- Foster has been charged with two counts of Felony Theft (LA RS 14:67) as a habitual offender
- Murray has been charged with one count of Felony Theft, also as a habitual offender

Due to Caldwell's repeated offenses, Shreveport Police are encouraging any retailers who recognize her or suspect she has stolen from their businesses to come forward. Additional charges may be pursued based on new evidence.
