SPD to Hold After-Action Report on Recent Multi-Agency Operation

The Shreveport Police Department, in collaboration with several local, state, and federal agencies, conducted a multi-faceted operation this week aimed at executing outstanding arrest warrants and addressing critical public safety issues in Caddo Parish and the City of Shreveport. This operation involved the Shreveport Police Department, Shreveport City Marshal's Office, Caddo Parish Juvenile Services, Office of Juvenile Justice, Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, Bossier Police Department, Louisiana State Probation & Parole, Louisiana State Police, ATF, FBI, District Attorney's Office, and the U.S. Attorney's Office.

For years, numerous warrants, particularly related to traffic violations and truancy offenses, had remained unexecuted. This operation addressed these outstanding warrants and focused on reducing traffic accidents, juvenile crime, and violent crime within the region.

The operation's key objectives included:

- Executing outstanding arrest warrants from various agencies, including Juvenile Courts, Shreveport City Marshal's Office, Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, and Shreveport Police Department.
- Addressing complaints related to firearms, narcotics, sex crimes, and domestic violence.
- Conducting probation searches and criminal patrols across Caddo Parish and the City of Shreveport.
- Coordinating efforts with Bossier Police Department to apprehend fugitives attempting to flee across city lines.

In response to the operation's progress and impact, the Shreveport Police Department will hold an After-Action Report on Monday at 3:30 PM. The meeting will take place at the Shreveport Police Department located at 1234 Texas in the second-floor assembly room. This session will provide a comprehensive review of the operation.
