Shreveport Police Seek Public's Help Locating Man Wanted for Forgery

Detectives with the Shreveport Police Department Financial Crimes Task Force are seeking the public's assistance in locating Timmy Bell, who is wanted for one count of Forgery.

On December 3, 2024, SPD Detectives were contacted by a victim who reported that her ex-husband, Timmy Bell, had fraudulently deposited a check belonging to her. The victim and Bell finalized their divorce in September 2024. However, after the divorce was finalized, Bell deposited the victim's check at Regions Bank on October 10, 2024.

The victim stated that the signature on the back of the check, valued at \$14,844.64, was not hers, and she did not authorize Bell to sign her name. Detectives, acting on a search warrant, obtained video surveillance footage from Regions Bank, which confirmed that Bell was the individual who deposited the check. Despite multiple attempts to contact Bell, he has refused to cooperate with the investigation. A warrant has been issued for his arrest for one count of Forgery.
