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Shreveport Police Seek Public's Help in Locating Two Suspects Wanted in Domestic Violence Cases - UPDATE



UPDATE: MILE/Bradley has been arrest. FOSTER IS STILL WANTED

The Shreveport Police Department is asking for the public's assistance in locating two individuals wanted in connection with separate domestic violence investigations.

Tyler Foster is wanted for an incident that occurred in April in the 9400 block of Mansfield Road. According to reports, Foster allegedly struck the female victim in the face multiple times and dragged her by the hair across a paved surface. Officers observed injuries consistent with the victim's account. Foster now faces one count of Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment. He has three prior arrests for domestic-related offenses.

Police are also searching for Jerricka Bradley, also known as Jerricka Miles, in connection with a domestic incident on May 13. During that incident, Bradley is accused of intentionally using force against the victim with a dangerous weapon, resulting in an injury to the victim's shoulder. Investigators also discovered that Bradley was violating a protective order by being present at the location. As a result, she is wanted for:

- One count of Violation of a Protective Order, and
- One count of Domestic Abuse Battery with a Dangerous Weapon.

Bradley has five prior arrests for domestic-related incidents.

The Shreveport Police Department takes domestic violence very seriously and remains committed to holding offenders accountable and protecting victims.
