Joint Operation Leads to Multiple Arrests and Firearm Seizures



The Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Abatement Team continues its commitment to reducing violent crime across our city. In a recent targeted operation on 5-30-25, the team partnered with the Shreveport City Marshal's Office, the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), and the Shreveport Police K-9 Unit to conduct a proactive enforcement initiative.

The multi-agency effort resulted in several arrests and the seizure of multiple firearms. The operation focused on individuals engaged in illegal activity involving narcotics, weapons, and outstanding warrants. The results of the operation are as follows:

Firearms Recovered: 4 illegally possessed weapons were seized during the operation.

The successful results of this operation demonstrate the effectiveness of coordinated enforcement efforts in removing illegal weapons and dangerous individuals from our streets.
