Domestic Violence Incident Leads to Arrests

On June 3, 2025, at approximately 3:00 a.m., Shreveport Police Department patrol officers contacted the Domestic Violence Unit following a domestic violence-related stabbing at a residence on Malcolm Street. Both individuals involved in the incident were detained on scene and later transported to the Investigations Bureau for questioning.

The individuals were identified as Jerricka Bradley and Tametria Bradley, a married couple with multiple children living in the home. Officers confirmed the children were present during both reported incidents.

Through the course of the investigation, detectives learned that Tametria Bradley is listed as a protected person in a court-issued protective order, with Jerricka Bradley named as the defendant following a 2023 domestic violence arrest. Additionally, Jerricka was previously arrested in May 2025 for violating that same protective order. Records indicate that Tametria had bonded Jerricka out after the May arrest and that Jerricka had been residing at the home since then.

At approximately 5:00 p.m. on June 2, Tametria contacted officers and reported a laceration to her right hand, stating that Jerricka had stabbed her with a pair of scissors during an argument. Hours later, at approximately 2:00 a.m. on June 3, officers were called to the home again in reference to a second stabbing. This time, Jerricka had sustained a laceration to her left ear.

Detectives conducted multiple interviews and determined that Tametria initially approached Jerricka during a verbal altercation while armed with scissors. Jerricka suffered minor scratches before disarming Tametria, which caused the laceration to Tametria's hand.

The two remained separated for the evening. Later, Tametria returned home in an intoxicated state and armed herself with a screwdriver. Another argument ensued, during which Tametria struck Jerricka in the side of the head. Jerricka did not initially realize she had been injured with the screwdriver until she noticed significant bleeding. She reportedly passed out from blood loss, prompting their 10-year-old son to run to a neighbor's house for help. When officers arrived, they located Tametria hiding under a pile of laundry.

As a result of the investigation:

- Tametria Bradley was arrested for *Domestic Abuse Battery Committed with a Dangerous Weapon* and *Domestic Abuse Battery with Child Endangerment* (six counts, covering both reported incidents).
- Jerricka Bradley was arrested for *Violation of Protective Orders*.
