## Firearms, Narcotics, and Body Armor Seized in Joint Operation — Two Convicted Felons Arrested

The Shreveport Police Department's Violent Crimes Abatement Team continues its mission to reduce violent crime and remove illegal firearms from the streets of our community. On June 3, 2025, just after 10:00 a.m., members of the team partnered with the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office to execute a search warrant in the 900 block of Wilton Street.

During the operation, officers recovered five semi-automatic firearms, one automatic firearm (machine gun), 18 marijuana plants, body armor, and additional narcotics from the residence.

Two individuals were taken into custody because of the investigation: Gabriel Jacobs and Kymmton Solomon.

- Jacobs was charged with:
  - Possession with Intent to Distribute Narcotics
  - Illegal Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon
  - Possession of a Firearm with a Controlled Dangerous Substance

Jacobs was determined to be a convicted felon due to a prior conviction for assault by drive-by shooting.

- Solomon was charged with:
  - Possession with Intent to Distribute Narcotics
  - Illegal Possession of a Firearm by a Convicted Felon
  - Possession of a Firearm with a Controlled Dangerous Substance
  - Possession of a Machine Gun
  - Probation Violations

Solomon was found to be a convicted felon based on a 2022 conviction for accessory after the fact to second-degree murder.

This operation was a coordinated effort involving the Shreveport Police Department, the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The joint effort reflects the ongoing commitment of local and federal agencies to identifying dangerous offenders and making our neighborhoods safer.
