Help Us Bring These Cowards to Justice

The Shreveport Police Department is asking for the public's help in identifying and capturing two violent offenders who carried out a reckless and targeted ambush in broad daylight.

On May 2, 2025, just after noon, officers responded to the area of West 69th Street and St. Vincent Avenue regarding reports of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a 19-year-old male who had been shot multiple times. He was rushed to a local hospital and, despite the severity of his injuries, he survived. His recovery is ongoing, and he is fortunate to be alive.

Detectives with the SPD Violent Crimes Unit determined that the victim was walking to a friend's home when two suspects exited a vehicle and opened fire on him—then fled the area. This was a calculated, unprovoked act of violence in the middle of the day, in a residential neighborhood.

We want to be very clear: this level of violence will not be tolerated in our city. These cowards carried out a senseless attack with no regard for life, and they must be held accountable.

If you know something—say something. Even the smallest tip could be the break we need to make an arrest and protect others from harm.
