Shreveport Police Department to Host Firearms Intelligence Training with Federal and Local Partners

On Wednesday, June 25th, the Shreveport Police Department will host a law enforcement-sensitive Firearms Intelligence Training in collaboration with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), the United States Attorney's Office, the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, the Caddo Parish District Attorney's Office, the Shreveport City Marshal's Office, and the LSU Shreveport Police Department.

The training will be held at the LSU Shreveport University Center and is scheduled to conclude at 12:00 PM. This course is expecting well over 100 officers in attendance.

This specialized session will focus on current issues surrounding privately made firearms (PMFs), machine gun conversions, homemade silencers, regional and national firearm trends, and strategies for building more prosecutable cases. Due to the sensitive nature of the information being presented, the course content is not open to the public.

However, media partners are invited to arrive at 11:45 AM to stage for interviews and coverage following the conclusion of the training.
