Shreveport Police Continue to Remove Firearms from Prohibited Individuals

The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to keeping firearms out of the hands of individuals who are legally prohibited from possessing them.

On June 26th, patrol officers arrested Kelvin Dotie, who was found in possession of a firearm. Dotie is prohibited from owning or carrying firearms due to a prior conviction stemming from a 1992 homicide case.

In a separate incident on June 23rd, officers arrested Kevin Wiggins after he was found in possession of a firearm and illegal narcotics. Wiggins is a convicted felon due to a 2019 attempted murder arrest, which resulted in a conviction for felony cruelty to a juvenile.

Both individuals have been removed from our streets, and their cases will be pursued to the fullest extent of the law.

Chief Wayne Smith continues to emphasize the importance of proactive policing to keep illegal firearms out of the hands of those who pose a danger to our community.
