Shreveport Police Make Arrest in Laurel Street Homicide

What was initially believed to be a fatal hit-and-run is now being investigated as a homicide, after Shreveport Police detectives uncovered evidence pointing to a deliberate act.

On June 28, 2025, at approximately 6:00 a.m., officers responded to a report of a deceased person in the 2100 block of Laurel Street. Upon arrival, they discovered the body of an elderly female in a vacant parking lot. Preliminary evidence at the time suggested the victim had been struck by an unknown vehicle while walking westbound along Laurel Street.

As the investigation progressed, detectives began to suspect that something more nefarious was at play. Through diligent investigative work, they identified the vehicle involved and ultimately determined that the victim had most likely been killed intentionally. The suspect, identified as Anthony Edwards, was located and taken into custody in Claiborne Parish. He was interviewed by Shreveport Police Violent Crimes detectives and has since been charged with one count of second-degree murder.

Investigators have confirmed that Edwards was known to the victim, and evidence suggests that his actions were intentional.

“This case is a tragic reminder of how quickly lives can be taken through senseless violence,” said Chief Wayne Smith. “We are grateful for the hard work of our detectives and the partnership with Claiborne Parish authorities in bringing this suspect into custody.”
