Shreveport Police Continue Crackdown on Illegal Firearms



The Shreveport Police Department remains committed to aggressively targeting gun crime and removing firearms from those who are prohibited from possessing them. Over the last several days, officers have made multiple arrests, taking both illegal weapons and dangerous offenders off our streets.

On July 6, 2025, officers arrested *Aurelius Blanks*, who was wanted for illegal use of a weapon. During the arrest, he was also found to be in possession of illegal narcotics and another firearm. He now faces charges for all three offenses. In a separate incident, proactive officers arrested *Javasiya Baulkman* during a traffic stop just after midnight. He was found to be in possession of a stolen handgun and taken into custody without incident.

On July 5, officers arrested *Brashay Goode*, who was wanted for aggravated burglary and aggravated assault with a firearm.

On July 4, *Shuntrell King* was arrested for illegal use of a weapon after a video surfaced showing her discharging a firearm into the air while standing in a front yard.

On July 6, *Tyrone Levy* was arrested for violating a restraining order and illegal use of a weapon. Earlier this morning, the Violent Crimes Abatement Team executed a search warrant at the Lifestyle Apartments. During the operation, officers arrested *James Perot*, a previously convicted felon, who was found in possession of a firearm. His previous convictions include multiple counts of aggravated assault with a firearm.

On July 3, officers responded to a call about a disorderly person at 4400 Hillary Huckabee. There, *Ladonald Sanders* was taken into custody for aggravated assault with a firearm, entering and remaining after being forbidden, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, possession of Schedule II narcotics, and illegal possession of a stolen firearm. Most recently, on July 7 just after midnight, officers arrested *Corbin West* on an outstanding warrant. He now faces one count of possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

The Shreveport Police Department is dedicated to protecting our community by proactively addressing violent crime and ensuring that firearms do not end up in the wrong hands. We thank the officers and specialized units whose efforts continue to make Shreveport a safer place.
